

Early College Credit Program

Elective or required

Length: One Semester

Credit: .25 high school credit for each 1 credit of post-secondary course

(Example: .75 high school credit for a 3 credit post-secondary course)

The Early College Credit program allows students who meet certain requirements to take post-secondary courses at a UW System college or private WI college. The purpose for participating in this program would be to take one or more college courses not comparable to HHS courses. Students receive high school and/or college credit. To qualify for this program, students must be in good standing both academically and in discipline/attendance, have maxed out all possible course options at HHS (if applicable), and meet the criteria and timelines established by the post-secondary institution. The fall semester deadline is March 1st. The spring semester deadline is October 1st. See the school counselor for details.
