"OUR PATHWAY FORWARD" UPDATE #12 FOR JUNE 21, 2021

We were able to complete the 2020-2021 school year with all in-person learning for the students in the School District of Hilbert. We will continue to update "Our Pathway Forward" Plan and monitor the current health situation in regards to COVID-19 and seek guidance from the Calumet County Health Department to guide our decisions around the safety of our students and staff for Summer 2021 and School Year 2021-2022.

UPDATED ITEMS:



*Go to "optional" Mask/Face Covering in School. Either effective immediately June 22 or as of July 1, 2021.

*Discussions with Calumet County Health Dept. support the following:

-Case activity/disease incidence in our area has dropped substantially. Our burden rate is 46.6 or "moderate". The current positivity rate is 6.3% or 1 case per day over the last 2 weeks.

-We will continue to social distance as much as possible, use good ventilation in our buildings and continue hand washing practices.

-Science still supports face coverings for unvaccinated people and we will continue to support and encourage that for our families.

*We will continue to use the current quarantine guidelines as recommended. Students/staff who are vaccinated and do not have symptoms will not need to quarantine. Students/staff not vaccinated and that have symptoms or were close contacts to a COVID-19 case will need to quarantine.

"OUR PATHWAY FORWARD" UPDATE #12 FOR JUNE 21, 2021

We were able to complete the 2020-2021 school year with all in-person learning for the students in the School District of Hilbert. We will continue to update "Our Pathway Forward" Plan and monitor the current health situation in regards to COVID-19 and seek guidance from the Calumet County Health Department to guide our decisions around the safety of our students and staff for Summer 2021 and School Year 2021-2022.

UPDATED ITEMS:

*If the community transmission rate would begin to creep up significantly, we recommend reverting back to the "mask/face covering" mandate in schools.

*The following schools are currently "optional" on masking: Kimberly, Hortonville, New Holstein, Seymour, Freedom, Little Chute, Neenah, Kaukauna, Omro, New London and Appleton. Shiocton is "situational" masking and Menasha, Brillion and Chilton are masking until June 30, 2021.

*Bring a proposal for the 2021-2022 school year to the July 26, 2021 Board Meeting. I anticipate optional masking for the start of the school year and masking required on buses for transportation, but that may change. The School District will strongly encourage and promote students getting vaccinated.
